# V. FILLING BOARD VACANCIES

In the event that there is a vacancy on the Board caused by the resignation or death of a Board member, this vacancy shall be filled by an individual selected by a quorum of the remaining Board members. The Board shall select an individual to serve within a reasonable time following the occurrence of the vacancy. An individual selected by the Board to fill a vacancy shall serve the remainder of the unexpired term.

The vote of the Board to fill a vacancy shall be carried out as follows:

- 1. The Board shall direct the Chief to distribute and publish a notice of the vacancy, the procedure for application, and the required application form, if applicable.
- 2. The Chairperson shall call for a discussion of potential replacements.
- 3. The Board members may nominate replacement candidates and all members of the Board shall then vote on all such nominations collectively until one candidate receives the majority of the votes cast. In the event that there is a deadlock in the voting, the process shall continue until such a replacement is selected.
- 4. Once an individual is selected by a majority vote, the Chairperson shall call for a motion for that person to fill the vacancy on the Board for the unexpired balance of the term created by the vacancy.
- 5. The Chairperson shall direct the Fire Chief to notify the selected replacement Board member.

The Fire Chief and/or a Board member may schedule a work session for the new Board member to acquaint him/her with the District's facilities, equipment, personnel, and to provide him/her with copies and an overview of pertinent District policies.

## VI. TRAINING

In order to meet the statutory requirements set forth in A.R.S. 48-803, each Board Member shall attend the prescribed six hours of professional training provided by the Arizona Fire District Association. Board members shall complete the training within one year after the date of the certification of their election. This training shall address open meeting laws, finance and budget matters and laws relating to fire district governance and other matters that are reasonably necessary for the effective administration of a fire district.

# VII. COMPENSATION

The Board shall serve without compensation, but may be reimbursed for any actual and reasonable expenses incurred on behalf of the District which are authorized by the Board.
