Roll Call – Present: Webber, Dorney, Archibald, Johnson; absent: Bahti

Call to the Public – none

Approval of the Minutes of 16 Dec 2019 – Motion to the minutes of 16 Dec 2019 as presented was made by Archibald, seconded by Dorney, motion carried.

Chief's Report:

- December run report: 41
- Total number of runs for 2019: 58, (A-shift 204, B-shift 199, C-shift 204)
- Laughlin Conference was very good, well-attended for a non-election year.
- EMS, Fire, Support Volunteers – we will be implementing an agility/skills test for each section
- Grants – we have two we are working on, the first was just submitted (Arizona Community Foundation) for safety vests, lights and traffic cones; the second is coming up, we'd like to apply for a FEMA Grant (AFG) for an ambulance.
- IGA with Palominas is going well; Palominas is expecting their new engine to be delivered May-ish, staffing levels have improved & we have two reserves.
- SEFD will begin projecting (on the PowerPoint) the financials again, we just have to cut them into smaller sections to be able to read them.

Agenda #4: Discussion and possible action on accepting the FY2019 Audit report from Jay Parke of Walker & Armstrong audit firm. Jay Parke discussed the four reports that result from our annual audit complete with their “unmodified opinion” – auditor language for finding a “clean” audit. There were no “material weaknesses or significant deficiencies” found. He stated the Sonoita-Elgin Fire District was in a strong financial position. He also advised the Board that the firm had no difficulties with the administration during the performance of the audit work. Motion to accept the FY2019 Audit was made by Dorney, seconded by Webber; motion passed unanimously.

Agenda #3: Monthly Financial Reports: Financials presented by V. Rutter for both the months of November and December were presented. Chief De Wolf presented the information as MS Rutter’s voice had given out.

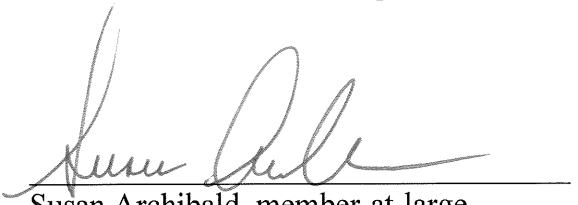

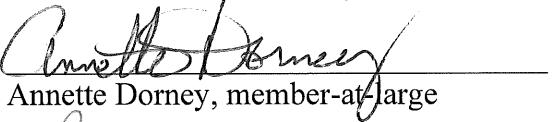

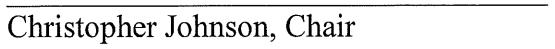
